Overview of precautions and measures taken to mitigate patient and practitioner risk of Covid 19 infection

	To be reviewed on change of Government guidance or by the 31st of October if sooner.
Heightened cleaning regimes	- Clinic room will be cleaned and aired between in each patient visit, this included: surfaces, linen (if used) and practitioner clothing. Alternatively single use plastic aprons will be in use if not practical to change clinic coats between visits. - Common areas will be cleaned regularly throughout the day - Washrooms will be cleaned regularly throughout the day - Practitioner will wash hands before and after each patient, and/or use 60% or higher alcohol hand sanitizer as necessary during the consultation. - Patients will be asked to use hand sanitizer, on arrival. - For the time being I cannot provide toys or books to entertain babies or children, so please bring your own with you.
Increased protection measures	- Practitioner will be wearing a mask throughout the consultation, and will use single use gloves during each treatment. - Patients please wear a mask over your nose and mouth throughout the consultation if able.
Put in place distancing measures	- A minimum of 5 minutes allowed between appointments to allow for cleaning of the room. - Please arrive promptly for your appointment, but please DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY. If you are arriving by car, please wait for a call from your practitioner to say they are ready for you to enter the building. If you are running late please notify me on 07891255712. - Ideally no chaperones, and only one parent per child, unless we have agreed this in advance. - Where possible social distancing measures will be maintained. - Patients will receive an electronic covid-symptom screening form within the 24-hour period before an appointment to check you and your household are well enough to go ahead with the appointment. - If you feel unwell please inform me BEFORE arriving for your appointment, please also inform me if you feel unwell within 3 days following your appointment.
